She made a sacrifice and showed that indeed a woman holds the sharp end of the knife by selling her house for her son to complete his undergraduate studies, to which Mr Thaba is still in awe and grateful to date. In 2016 he enrolled at Boston Media for a Diploma in Media Practice and this is where he was exposed to all the fundamentals of film making. In the same year he started his own Media Production company called Kagiso Media Production Studio, and registered it with SARS for tax purposes.

It is not all the time that everyone will share your visions with you and the same holds true for Mr Thaba- his vision was only his alone to foresee and he had to become the director, producer, script writer and manager of the production and he has never been more happy to have gone through this journey to understand every nook and cranny pertaining to production. Later, he went to the University of Limpopo to pursue an undergraduate Bachelor of Arts qualification in Media Studies. performance was exceptional and he made it out with a Cum Laude and was recognized as one of the top achievers in his field.

Unfortunately he could not even celebrate his achievements because it was during the Covid-19 lockdown and everything was done online, "it was such an honour to graduate my Bachelor`s degree in Media Studies with an outstanding performance. I have never imagined outshining my fellow graduates with a Cum Laude degree" Mr Thaba expressed himself. Even though he did not make it to that stage and could not have the grand celebration he was planning for, his spirit was still cheerful and he imagined himself wearing that gown and walking on the red carpet.

Coming from a poor background and his daily activities have always been the drive and motivation behind his hard work. During the midst of Covid-19, he always remained hopeful and maintained his hard work and commitment and the results vouch for him. His passion in media and communications is also one of the things that made him to progress in his studies. If you know the struggle and how hard you fought to get to where you are you would always incubate whatever it is that you have. Sometimes life gives us so many opportunities, but we do not always comprehend and value them because not everyone is that fortunate. He feels sad at the fact that he had to commence his degree at a later age than he had hoped, but his love and passion kept him going. Not having a sponsorship, worrying about where he will live and his overall expenses ached him a lot at the time, through unfavourable but even the circumstances he had to go through, Mr Thaba has a different story to tell now; he came out a victor against all odds.

In 2021, he made a journey to the city of milk and honey, of endless possibilities and opportunities and pursued an Honour's degree in Film and Television. He started attending film workshops and auditioned for featured roles. He was cast in several SABC Television shows such as Generations and Muvhango as a body guard and Mzansi Magic Soap Operas, Diepcity as Tsotsi, Side Dish and The Republic as a Prison Warden, and Lingashoni as a journalist, to name a few.

Then he worked for the department of Politics and International Relations at the University of Johannesburg as an assistant to the Head of Department in the following year, 2022, where he was conducting research, writing book chapters, organizing and overseeing the general work in the department. Early 2023 he served as a Student Debtors and Registration Assistant at the Finance Department in the university. He was doing accounting, examining financial statements, daily account records, answering phone calls, writing emails and having face to face consultation sessions answering student queries, among others. He is also a passionate photographer- he was a photographer for Limpopo TV, he has worked very closely to many celebrities and has covered the 2019 Mapungubwe art festival, modelling and events.

Currently he was shooting the African Union Model Summit, where they had delegates from abroad and also had a chance to work closely with the Vice Chancellor of the University of Johannesburg.

Mr Thaba feels that having to work to pay for his tuition fees took a toll on him. There are times where he was met with multiple deadlines and he still had to show up for work. He feels that if he could, he would have waited until he got a bursary to fund for his studies before he pursued them.

He is in the midst of finishing up his Master's degree at one of the top universities in the world for this reason. Despite all the difficulties he had to face, he is still standing and willing to advance even further. He has come to realize that he has a perseverance and persistence-oriented spirit, which is another quality of his character. He always aspires to go higher since he is a go-getter.
