"I don't know anyone who has ever gotten to the top without hard work. The road to success is not easy to navigate, but with hard work, passion and drive its possible to achieve dreams"

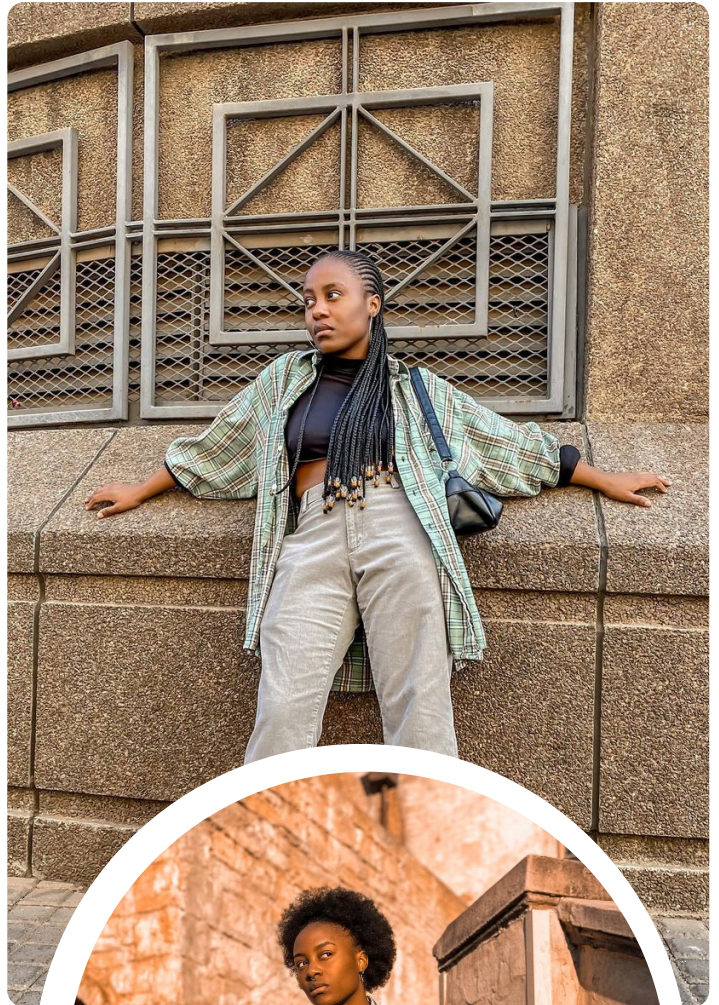
